Regional activities will include, but not be limited to; being the local technical resource to CPCI members and clients, organizing and facilitating the regional chapter meetings, conducting lunch and learns with the Architecture, Engineering and Construction (AEC) community, acting as a spokesperson to the various industry audiences, representing the industry at conferences, and advocacy where required. Nationally, activities will include, but not be limited to, working as the lead staff person on the Sustainability, Productivity and Safety committee, supporting the other National committees where required, and writing, reviewing and editing technical manuals and best practice documents that are routinely published by the institute.

CREDENTIALS AND EXPERIENCE

The ideal candidate will be a professional engineer (P.Eng.) with a minimum of ten years of experience either in a plant environment, or direct engineering design and/or business development and sales experience in the precast concrete industry. Previous experience with not-for-profit trade associations and Boards, either in a voluntary or staff position, would be beneficial. Strong verbal, presentation and written communication skills are a mandatory requirement.
